
Title of the Talk: Aiming for a Strong Mental Health and Personality to Overcome Bullying and Social Exclusion Within and Beyond Campus

Brief Biography of Dr. Jugal Kishore:

Dr. Jugal Kishore has been actively involved in India's Social, Mental, and Environmental Health Movement. He has **published** more than **330 research papers** in journals, magazines, and dailies (https://scholar.google.co.in/citations? <u>user=jsDekV0AAAAJ&hl=en</u>), with more than **6800 citations**. He has contributed to many chapters in books. He has authored more than 40 books on public health, **national programs, social reform, and rationality**. He is an editor of many Journals and chair of many prestigious boards and task forces in government agencies. He is known for the development of public health education in the country. His contribution has been recognized by several awards, including **Dr S Radhakrishnan Memorial Teacher Award, the Lifetime Achievement Award for promoting** AYUSH 2020, and the Hakeem Ajma Khan International Award 2021. The University of Queensland Brisbane Australia awarded for special contribution to Sub-Project 7: Strengthening the National Capital Center for Occupational & Environmental Health, Delhi, 1999-2001. Due to his scientific achievements, he has been elected as a Fellow of the National Academy of Medical Sciences (NAMS), India, the International Medical Science Academy (IMSA), the Indian Association of Preventive and Social Medicine (IAPSM), Indian Public Health **Association**. He has organized over 100 conferences, workshops, symposiums, and quest lectures. He has delivered almost 400 quest lectures, panels, and invited speeches. He has participated in more than 60 online sessions and more than 20 interviews on radio and television. His mission is to liberate society through education and the development of public health.
